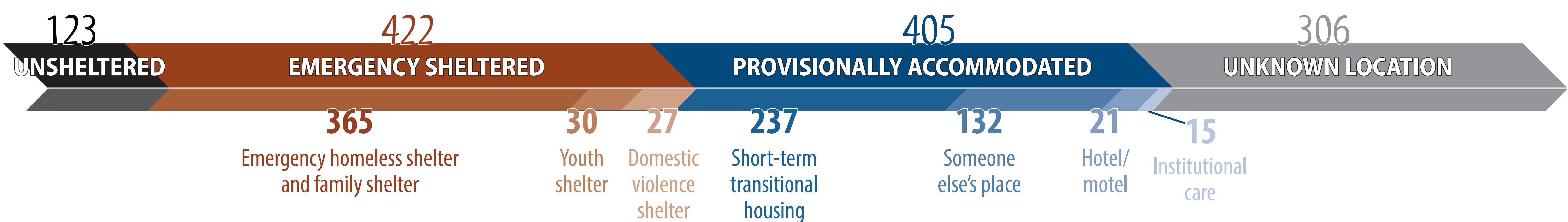

## MORE THAN



WERE ON **EMPLOYMENT AND INCOME ASSISTANCE**

- > MORE THAN **1/2** HAVE EXPERIENCE WITH **CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES**
- > **54%** FIRST EXPERIENCED HOMELESSNESS AT OR BEFORE 18 YEARS OLD
- > **92.3%** ARE INDIGENOUS
